The California Department of Transportation, working with the Riverside County Transportation Commission, proposes to widen Interstate 215 from Murrieta Hot Springs Road to Scott Road in Riverside County.

Please attend a public meeting to learn about this project and review the Initial Study that has been conducted to analyze the effects of the project on the environment. Please join us on:

The meeting will include maps and other exhibits that will show the proposed widening of the freeway from two lanes to three lanes in both the northbound and southbound directions by adding a third mixed-flow lane within the freeway median. The project also proposes to include an asphalt concrete pavement overlay on the current freeway lanes in both directions.

During this informal, "open house" style meeting, visitors will have an opportunity to view project maps, provide written comments and ask questions about the proposed widening project. Qualified staff will be on hand to answer questions.
